

BIRD field guide

Superb Fairy-wren Malurus cyaneus

When to look: Breeds June to February

Male: rich blue and black plumage above and on the throat. Belly is grey-white and beak is black.

Similar species:

Other predominantly blue male fairy-wrens have either chestnut shoulder patch or blue underparts

Male (eclipse): mostly brown above with dull red-orange area around eye and brown beak
