

MAMMAL field guide

Grey-headed Flying-fox Pteropus poliocephalus

When to look:

September to April at night during feeding

Distinctive fur on its legs that extends to its ankles

Black wings

Similar species:

Another flying fox won't have leg fur, which extends to the ankle on the Greyheaded Flying-fox.

Dark grey to brown body

Golden-orange fur encircling its neck

Lighter grey fur on its head
