

# How to be a good ClimateWatcher



## SPECIES

Check the field guides and app info before you submit a sighting.

Have you identified the right species? Is it found in your area?

ClimateWatch is interested in the behaviours listed for each species. For example, look for magpies that are swooping, calling, or on a nest.



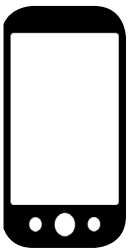
## SIGHTINGS

Submit a photo for each sighting.

Don't use a friend's photo or one from the Internet!

Take a close up shot of leaves, flowers, seeds, insects or animals.

Only submit sightings of wild animals.



## SMARTPHONE

Make comments of where you are when you submit a sighting, to verify your location.

If you're in a group, it's still important that you all make a sighting. This makes the data more reliable.

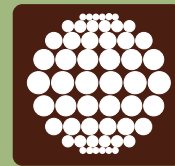


## SCREEN

Check your Sightings List regularly to make sure your sightings are uploaded.

Edit your sightings if you think you've made a mistake.

Download the smartphone app from iTunes or Google Play.
