

Identifying a Species

Where to begin?

- Before you head out, familiarize yourself with your local <u>ClimateWatch indicator</u> <u>species</u>
- Click on your <u>local trail</u> to find species you're likely to see
- Click on the <u>species page</u> to find identification guides
- Access these guides through the app by clicking on the icon in the species list





Basics of Identification

- Plants Look at the body, leaves, flowers, fruits or seeds. What colour, shape or pattern do you see?
- Birds Look at the colouring, size and shape of the bird's body, eyes and beak
- Mammals Look at the colouring, size and shape of the animals body, face and ears
- Insect Look at the bug's mouth, its body's colouring and wings (if it has any)
