

FROG field guide

Giant Tree Frog or White-lipped Tree Frog *Litoria infrafrenata*

When to look: September to April

Bright green-olivepale brown body

> Tip: Listen for its call: a loud, harsh barking sound that resembles a strong repeated tapping or "tonk...tonk...tonk" sound

White strip along its lower lip, extending below its ear patch to its arm

Similar species:

The Green Tree Frog is smaller (10cm long) and lacks the white stripe running along its lower lip. White belly

Half-webbed fingers

Fully webbed toes
