## Honey Bee Apis mellifera

When to look: Early spring to weather below 13°C

## Similar species:

A wasp: has yellow legs, brighter yellow bands on its abdomen and lacks the hairiness of the Honey Bee.

Native Australian Bees: while it is difficult to see, native bees don't have hairy eyes like the Honey Bee. Also a Honey Bee usually has obvious "baskets" full of pollen on its legs. Hairy abdomen with black and brown (or yellow or orange) stripes.
