

MARINE field guide

Elephant Snail Scutus antipodes

Shell never covers the full length of their body

Where to look:

Mid to lower shore (mid to low tide). Rock pools, water filled crevices and under surfaces of rocks Can tolerate mid exposure, but prefer moist conditions

Semi-rare solitary marine snail

Similar species:

The Elephant snail is easy to identify because of its large size and black colour. Black flesh with a small white, shield-like shell

Size: up to 15 cm
