

## Coastal Rosemary *Westringia fruticosa*

When to look:  
*Flowers in summer*

### *Similar species:*

Creeping myoporum  
(*Myoporum parvifolium*)  
has thicker, broader leaves  
and flowers March-May and  
September-November.

Large shrub, up to  
2m high and 5m  
wide.

Dark green leaves  
with short hairs on the  
underside. Up to 2cm long,  
narrow and pointed, and  
close to the stem. Dense  
foliage



2cm across, forming a fan-  
shape around the stem.  
White or pale purple with  
reddish and yellow spots  
near the throat.
